THE INITIAL BUSINESS CASE

COULD YOU SUMMARISE THE INITIAL BUSINESS CASE FOR PROCURING SUCH A SYSTEM?

Blackpool Council has been using the Concerto software since 2007. The initial brief was to provide a centralised asset management database, data previously being held in various locations and formats. The Concerto software closely matched the Council's brief. Some areas of the system had to be amended to accommodate the Council's working practices, and this was included as part of the initial contract. Since installation in 2007 the Council has added various modules and enhancements and are due to implement another 2 modules shortly. Further expansion of the system is planned in 2014 and 2015. The Council is fully committed to this system and it has proven to be invaluable in managing the property portfolio.
